Cam Miller is a retired educator turned professional fine art photographer who lives in New Market, Maryland. After living and teaching on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, she moved in 2010 to Central Maryland, where she is fully engaged in the arts community.

Cam has taken courses in digital photography at Maine Media Workshops, as well as at photography conferences like FotoFusion and Photoshop World. She has studied light painting privately with Harold Ross. Her digital painting workshops were taken with Karen Burns and Marie Otero of PhotoPaintWorks.

Awards include the Vincent Versace Award for Digital Photography of Excellence (2012), first place in the professional division of the Art In Nature Festival (2011 and 2012), and third place in Light and Shadow at the Blanche Ames Gallery (2013). Numerous works have been accepted into juried art competitions and exhibits in the Mid-Atlantic area.

She is a member of The Ward Museum, the Delaplaine Visual Arts Center, the Maryland Federation of Art, and the Frederick Arts Council. She belongs to the Maryland Professional Photographers' Association and the Professional Photographers of America. She currently serves as the co-chair of *Easels in Frederick*, one of the leading plein air painting competitions on the East Coast.

Cam teaches photography classes at Frederick Community College as well as does private tutoring.
